# Cash SUD 2022 Annual Drinking Water Quality Report Now Available Online at <u>https://cashwater.org/ccr1,</u> on our Facebook Pg, or in our office.

The State of Texas and federal government requires testing of your drinking water to ensure its health & safety. Each year Cash SUD closely monitors the water both at the source and throughout our system. Samples are taken and tested at different intervals; some testing is done monthly, quarterly, annually, and there are a few specific samples that are only taken every few years.

Cash Special Utility District's annual drinking water quality report (aka consumer confidence report) communicates the results of those tests to you, our customer, every year. The report covers the analysis of samples that were taken January 1 through December 31, 2022.

Cash SUD's drinking water surpassed the strict regulations of both the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).


### **NEW UNION VALLEY PUMP STATION**

The current pump station in Union Valley has no room left to add additional storage or even a larger pump house building. The District has simply outgrown the current Union Valley Pump Station. With no room to grow, the District purchased 14 acres not far from the existing pump station. The new location (previously Union Valley Feed Store) has frontage on State Highway 276 as well as a large power supply on site.


As seen below in the site plan, the new pump station will consist of two 500,000 gallon concrete ground storage tanks, a 36-foot by 24-foot pump house with a capacity of 3,000 gpm (gallons per minute) pump, and a disinfection booster station to further improve water quality.

This pump station is designed to meet our growth for the next twenty years.

Once this new station is in operation, the old facilities will be removed and the land cleaned up.

# TAKE THE GUESS WORK OUT OF KNOWING WHEN AND HOW MUCH TO WATER

If you have a programmable irrigation system, we have just the thing for you. Cash SUD has partnered with Texas A&M AgriLife Extension to provide detailed information about when and how much to water your yard according to current local weather data. Please read fhe following from <u>WaterMyYard.org</u>.

"<u>WaterMyYard.org</u> uses local weather data in sponsored areas to provide free weekly watering advice. This data is collected from an extensive network of weather stations and rain gauges, and, along with researchbased understanding of plant water needs, allow experts to send customized weekly water advice for your specific lawn and irrigation system.

### Drop the High-Water Bill

WaterMyYard is a science-based tool that helps take the guesswork out of determining when and exactly how much to water. Over-watering contributes to runoff, and broken or poorly maintained irrigation systems can make things even worse. Its not uncommon for up to half of the water applied to a home's landscape to be wasted, never taken up by the plants. WaterMyYard can help your water bill, while at the same time helping to conserve Texas water resources for the future.

### A Healthy Lawn Is A Properly Watered Lawn

The WaterMyYard program is a tool to assist you in determining the precise amount of supplemental water that is needed to maintain a healthy lawn. A vibrant green yard might even need less water than you think. If fact, many lawn problems are compounded by over-watering or by applying water at the wrong time.

### **Free Weekly Recommendations**

The WaterMyYard tool works great to make sure the water lost by your plants and the soil is replenished, and the tool provides watering recommendations for the upcoming week. Because it can't predict future rainfall events, you may still receive a recommendation to run your irrigation system when rain is in the local forecast. If so, consider taking a wait and see approach to let mother nature do the watering for you."

Water<sub>My</sub>Yard Ø








